### **BIOPSY AFTERCARE:**

- Remove bandage from the biopsy area after 24 hours.
- After removing the bandage, clean the area with soap and water.
  - If your biopsy has sutures, do not submerge in water (pool, ocean, hot tub) showering and cleaning are okay.
  - If your biopsy does not have sutures, you can submerge in water, but please perform biopsy aftercare when you get out of the water.
- Use a clean towel to gently pat the area dry, avoid rubbing.
- After cleaning and drying, Apply Polysporin, Bacitracin, Vaseline, or Aquaphor to the biopsy area.
- Cover the area with a new bandage.
- Repeat this process daily until it is completely healed.
- Results can take up to 2 weeks.

### **NORMAL HEALING**

Mild redness around the biopsy site, crusting, scabbing

### **SIGNS OF INFECTION**

Increasing redness, pus or fluid draining from the biopsy site, increasing pain or tenderness.
